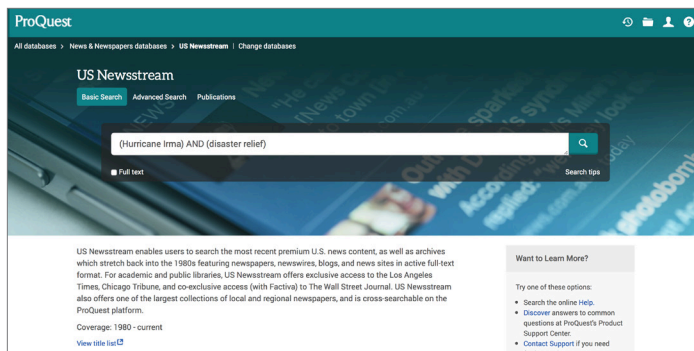

2. **It's easy.** The ProQuest interface offers user-friendly and precise search experience with features including:
 - Ability to narrow searches by date, multiple fields, and document types
 - Abstracts for every newspaper article
 - On demand article translation in 13 different languages
 - Multi-lingual interface (18 languages available)
 - Text-to-speech capability
3. **You'll have the most current news at your fingertips.** ProQuest news content is updated each day. Access hundreds of full-text newspapers on the ProQuest interface with same day publication access to over 250 titles.
4. **Teachers and professors recommend it.** According to a recent ProQuest survey, (88%) of researchers who also teach recommend newspapers to their students, indicating the value of newspapers for all levels of research.

- Limit to newspapers only

 - In the date column, click the latest column to narrow to results 2010-2017
 - Sort by Most Recent First
